



How to Generate an IMD Statistic Summary

Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) are used to rank the relative deprivation of small neighbourhoods in England across several domains, including income, employment, health and crime. You can use Views to report on the relative deprivation of the Participant and Venue postcodes collected within your account*

To generate an IMD statistic summary:

- Hover over **Intelligence** and select **Statistic Summaries**
- Click on **Actions**
- Select **Legacy Statistic Summaries**
- Click on the **Plus** icon 
- Click on either the **Participants (IMD)** or the **Venues (IMD)** summary
- Enter a **Start Date** and **End Date**
- Add **Work Filters** if required
- Click **Apply** to run the report

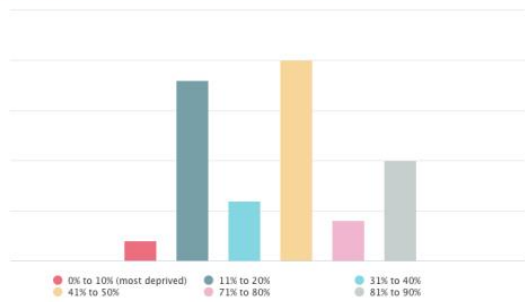

The report will provide the relative deprivation decile for each record attending at least once in the report period. Statistics are given for each of the separate domains, as well as for the combined Index of Multiple Deprivation.

1.1 Count Of Participants By Index Of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) Decile



Item	Count
0% to 10% (most deprived)	1
11% to 20%	9
31% to 40%	3
41% to 50%	10
71% to 80%	2
81% to 90%	5
